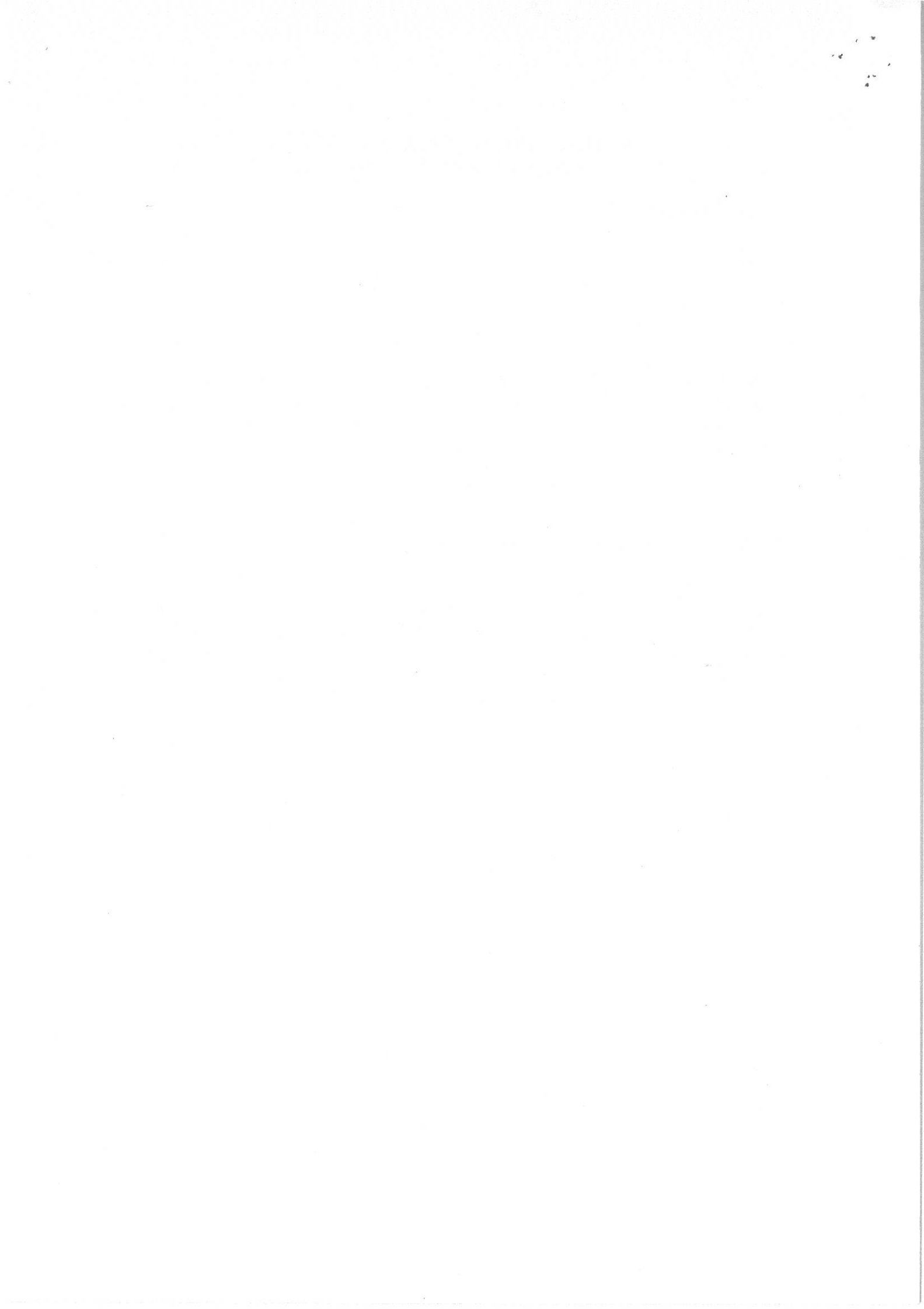

E-Learning

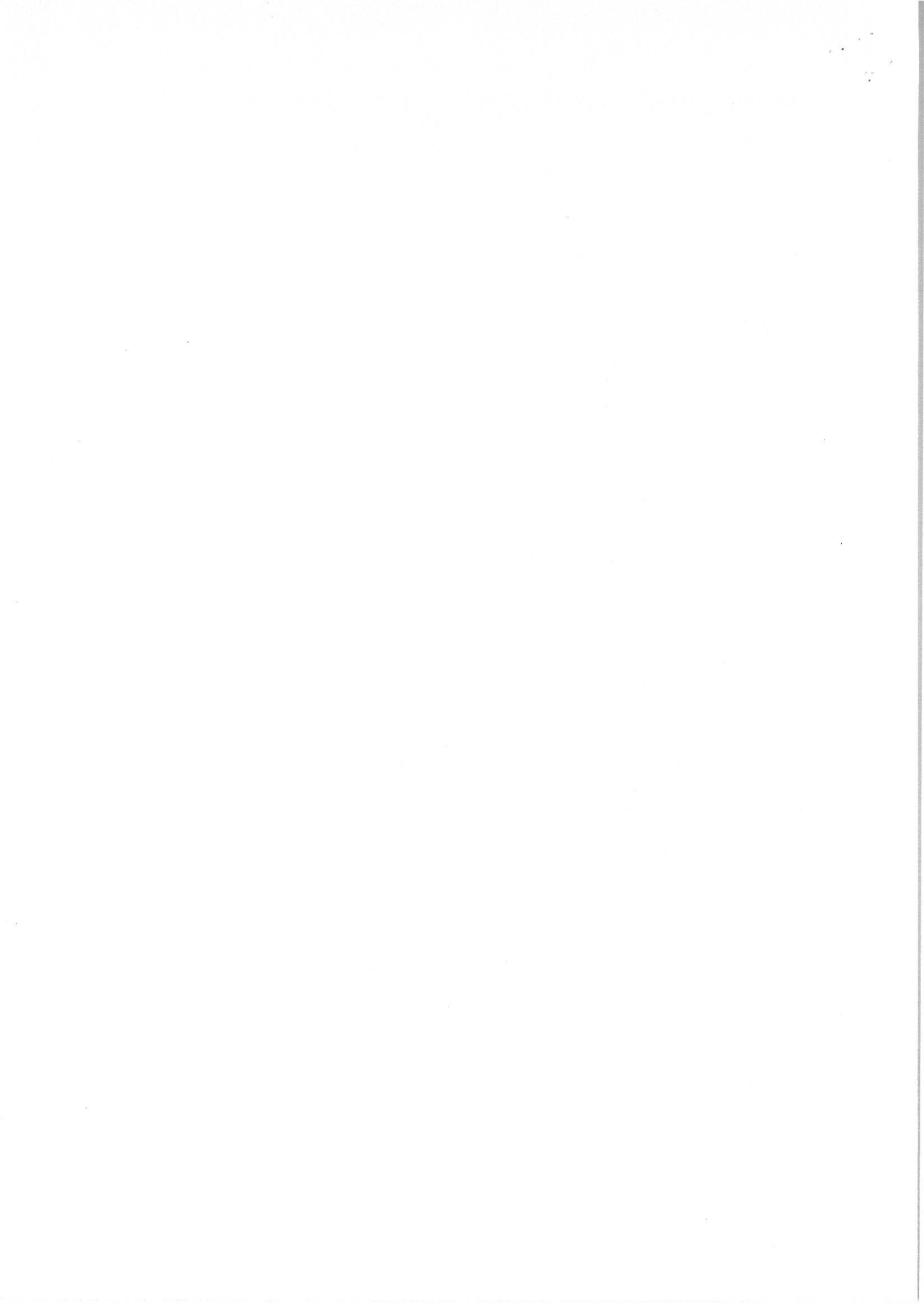

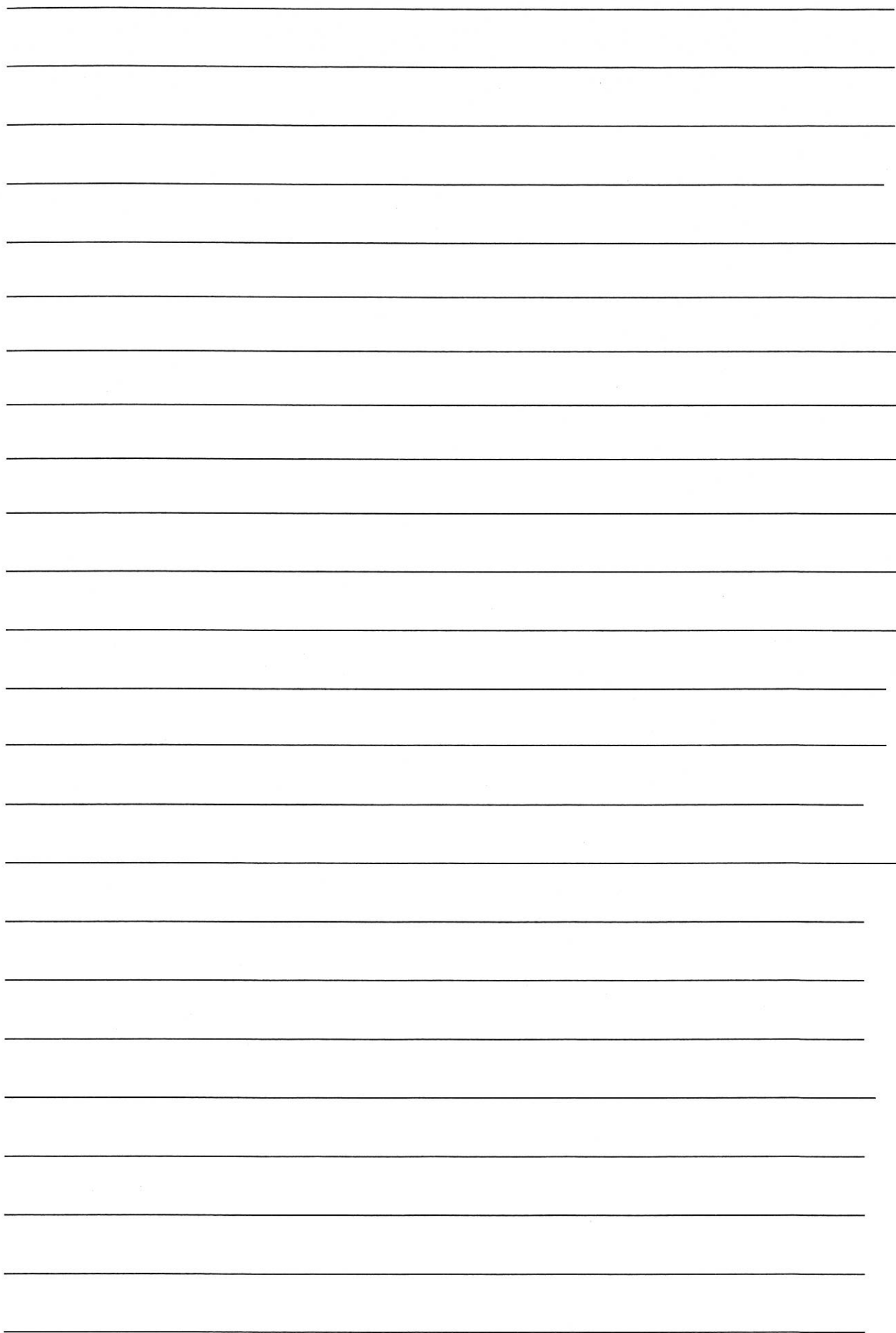

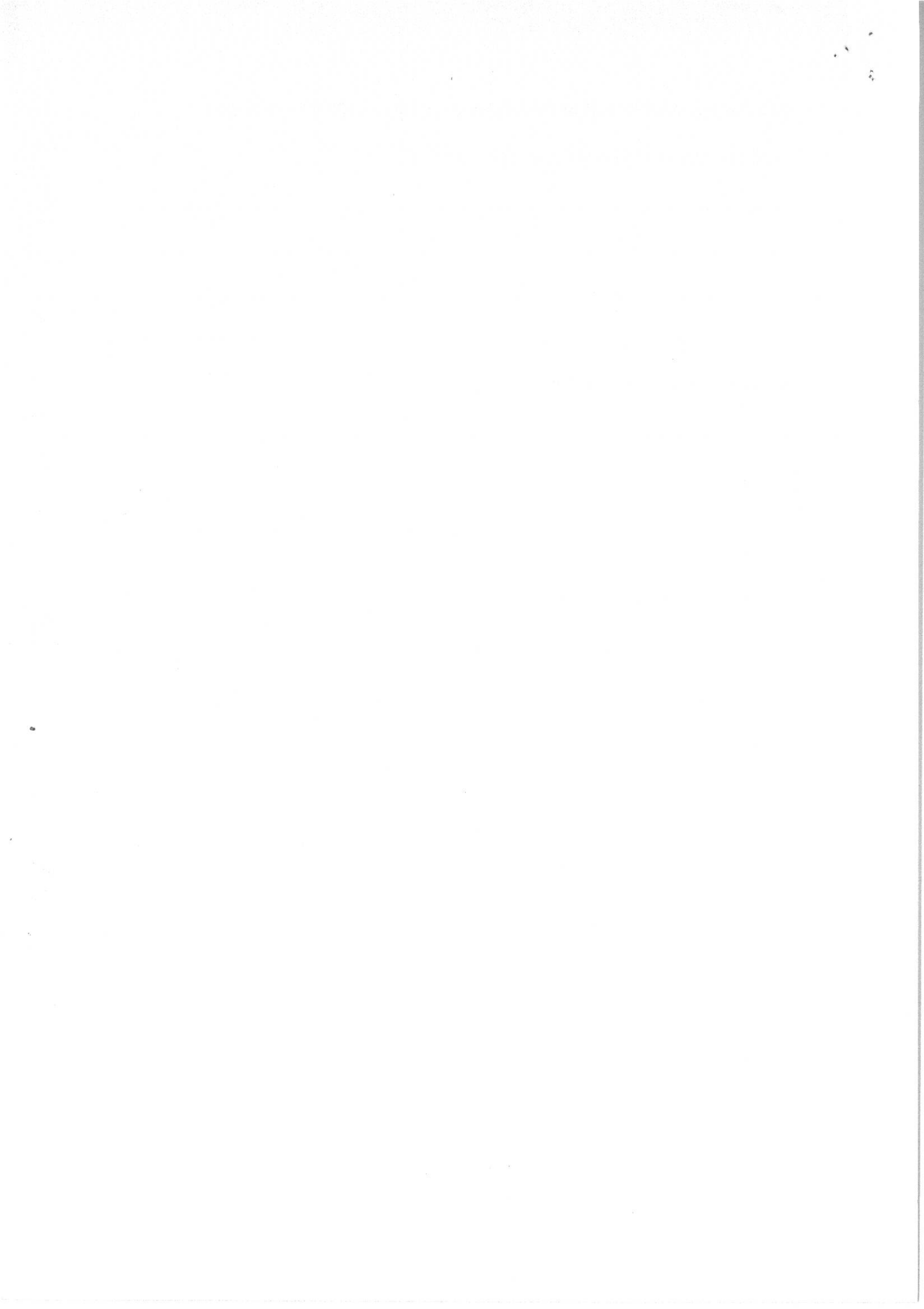
